# **Educational maintenance allowances - support for staying on in education**

You may be interested one of the ways the Government is helping young people make the most of their education.

For young people throughout Charnwood constituency to prosper, it is vital that they be given a chance to maximize their potential. Evidence shows that young people who continue their education past 16 learn more, earn more and contribute more to our community. That's why I'm pleased that the Government is launching educational maintenance allowances. The allowance is available to all 16-19 year olds from families with an annual income of less than £30,000 a year-that's more than half of all families.

The allowance is paid direct to the student, as long as they attend classes and show real progress. It can be used to fund textbooks, travel or any other purpose the student wishes and there will be bonuses for achievements and learning.

I encourage every family with a child who is leaving secondary school this year and has an annual income of less than £30,000 or less to apply for this allowance- even if your child has not yet decided whether to stay on in education this September - if they apply now, the benefit will be paid straight away in September if they choose to stay on in education. Here's a ready reckoner to see how much this allowance could be worth

£19,631 to £24,030 per annum	£20/week
£24,031 to £30,000 per annum	£10/week
