

# RESIDENTS 'IN LIMBO' OVER NEW HS2 PLAN

Residents are being 'left in limbo' over plans for the new high-speed rail link HS2, a politician has claimed.

The high speed train - which

will travel from London to Leeds and Manchester - will run alongside the M1 and is planned to cut through Nuthall.

Nuthall councillor Philip Owen said that about ten houses are planned to be demolished in the village to make way for the train.
